### I am the Lord's Servant

**Big Idea:** *God's call is a gracious gift, inviting us to trust His plan, embrace His work in us, and respond with a faithful "yes."*

#### **Read Luke 1: 26-38**

- 1. When the angel appeared to Mary, he said, "The Lord is with you." The title "Lord" means God owns us and has the right to decide for us. How comfortable are you with God owning you and having the right to decide for you? Is He Lord? Of everything? Are there areas where you struggle to acknowledge Him as Lord? How can we come to accept trusting his authority and decision making power over every area of our life?**
- 2. When God called Mary, he described her as "favored." In other words, God's call on her life was a gift, and not an obligation. Do we view the opportunities and assignments that God gives us as obligations or gifts? How can we cultivate an attitude of gratitude for the assignments that God appoints to us?**
- 3. Mary's question, "How will this be, since I am a virgin?" reflects a legitimate inquiry into the mystery of God's plan. How do you handle situations where God's call seems to defy human logic, understanding, or personal peace? Can you think of a time when you had to trust God's promise without knowing the "how"? What did you learn from that experience?**
- 4. Reflect on the idea of God "overshadowing" us to work in us and through us, as seen in Mary's story. What are some ways we have seen God work in and through our lives to demonstrate His love and power? How can we be more expectant of His "overshadowing" our daily lives and look for Him more intentionally?**
- 5. When Mary was called, she had a submissive attitude and resolve to obey her Lord. What needs to happen in our hearts to be able to echo**

***her words, "I am the Lord's servant," with trust and a willingness to follow His lead? What specific attitudes are needed to have a heart that aligns with God's will and embraces His call?***

***Closing Prayer Prompt:***

*Thank You for Your grace and the call You place on our lives. Like Mary, help us to trust Your plan and respond with willing hearts. Guide us to recognize Your presence and submit to Your will, embracing Your gifts with gratitude. May our lives reflect Your glory as You work through us.*
