Pass or Passport

Big Idea: *"When cruelty strikes, God hears and sends us, promising His presence, capability, and guidance to fulfill His mission."*

Read Exodus 3:1-15 & 4:1-5; 19-20

- 1. God is attentive to the pain and injustice in the world. How can we ensure that we are not passive but active participants in God's work of justice and compassion in our context?**
- 2. God often calls the busy and the productive to step into His plans. He doesn't typically call the idle. What everyday activities or routines might God be using to prepare you for a greater purpose? What attitudes are necessary to remain open and attentive to God's call to do something new for Him?**
- 3. Moses expresses his feelings of inadequacy, but God reassures him with the promise of His presence and capability. When you feel inadequate for a task God has placed before you, what practical steps can you take to rely on His strength rather than your own?**
- 4. God reveals Himself as "I AM WHO I AM." Which means I AM whatever you need to do whatever I have asked you to do. When obeying God, where do you feel most deficient or inadequate? How can you invite God to be your "I AM," trusting Him to be whatever you need to accomplish His purposes?**
- 5. Moses hesitated and the Lord's anger burned. It's God's way of saying, "this will happen with or without you. I will make a way, but I will not make you go." What did God get angry at Moses? When faced with a choice to step into God's calling, how can we overcome hesitation, knowing that God will make a way?**

Closing Prayer Prompt:

Heavenly Father, we come before You with hearts open to Your calling. We acknowledge the times we have felt inadequate or hesitant, and we thank You for being our "I AM," filling every deficiency with Your strength and presence. Help us to answer your call and respond with courage and compassion. Guide us to use the gifts and resources You've placed in our hands for Your glory. As we face choices in stepping into Your plans, grant us the faith to trust in Your way and the willingness to go where You lead.
