When God Cold Calls

Big Idea: *"Faith is not about our intentions or circumstances, but about trusting and acting on God's promises to bring hope and blessing to our lives and others."*

Read Genesis 11:27-12:7

- 1. Terah intended to go to Canaan but settled in Harran. Are there areas in your life where you have settled for less than what God has called you to? How can you move beyond good intentions to actual obedience?**
- 2. Abraham and Sarah were in a hopeless situation due to their childlessness. What is a situation in your life that feels hopeless? How can you invite God into that space to bring hope and transformation?**
- 3. God spoke to Abraham. How do you discern God's call in your life today? What steps can we take to ensure that we are hearing and responding to His call?**
- 4. Abraham acted on God's call without knowing all the details. What is one area where you feel God is calling you to step out in faith? What practical steps can you take to act on that call?**
- 5. Abraham built an altar to the Lord as a sign of his commitment. What "altars" or commitments can you establish in your life to signify your dedication to not returning to a faithless life? How do these commitments establish our resolve to not go back to a faithless life?**

Closing Prayer Prompt:

"Heavenly Father, thank You for calling us to a life of faith and hope. Help us to trust in Your promises and act on Your guidance, even when the path is unclear. Strengthen us to move beyond good intentions and into faithful obedience, so that we may be a blessing to others. In Jesus' name, Amen."
