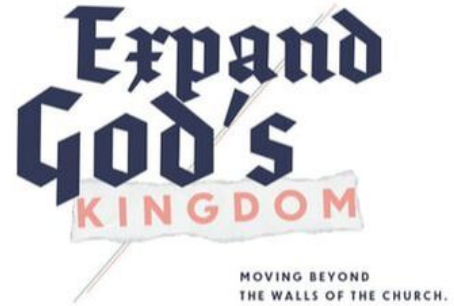


LG Questions Fall 22 WK 3



Big Idea: *How to reignite our passion and weather the winds of discouragement when it comes to sharing our faith.*

Read Jeremiah 20:7-13 & Jeremiah 1:14-20

1. What keeps you from sharing your faith with other people? Specifically discuss the things that discourage you.
2. Jeremiah felt like the Lord deceived him when he called him to be a prophet (Jeremiah 20:7-8). Have you ever felt like God asked you to do something and the journey of obedience was thwarted, manipulated, or a sham from the beginning? How did you combat those feelings and obey the Lord?

Read 2 Timothy 1:6-8

3. Scripture says, "God has not given us a Spirit of fear, but one of power, love, and sound judgment." What does power, love, and sound judgment look like when it comes to sharing our faith? (*Hint: It does not take power, love, and sound judgment to smile and be nice.*)

4. Paul tells Timothy “don’t be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord”. Why do you think Paul has to tell Timothy to “not” be ashamed?
5. Share a time that you shared the gospel with someone and it was a positive experience.

Prayer Focus: Our student ministry made a trip to Puerto Rico in 2017 after Hurricane Maria. Just this week, Puerto Rico was devastated by Hurricane Fiona. Please pray for the people of Puerto Rico who are displaced, in danger, and devastated. Ask for their protection, for physical, emotional, and spiritual comfort, and ask for an army of believers to GO assist them as they deal with the wake of devastation.
